**SUBJECT:** Class G Special Use Permit - Liquor License Applications for River's Edge Bar, Grill, Verita Restaurant and Fernando's Street Kitchen for the 2019 "Music Matters Summer Festival" organized by Jeffrey Matter to be held at 151 N. Island Ave (Peg Bond Center) on August 9 and 10, 2019.

This memorandum is regarding the management of liquor service for the upcoming "Music Matters Summer Festival" scheduled to take place on Friday, August 9 and Saturday, August 10, 2019. The event organizer, Jeff Matters of Music Matters, has indicated that liquor services for the event will be provided by 3 vendors: River's Edge Bar and Grill, Verita Restaurant and Fernando's Street Kitchen. Liquor service will run from 5-10 pm on this August 9<sup>th</sup> and from 1-10 pm on August 10<sup>th</sup>. Music Matters will provide event staff at all points of entry/exit to ensure alcoholic beverages are contained within the event area during service hours.

Authorized representatives for each licensed liquor holder are as indicated below:

- River's Edge Bar and Grill: Melissa Monno
- Verita Restaurant: Wendy DiBenedetto
- Fernando's Street Kitchen: Fernando Martinez

All liquor license vendors hold valid retail liquor licenses in the City of Batavia. The Police Department has reviewed the most recent liquor license background investigation completed on these businesses and we have found no problems which would preclude the businesses or the owners/operators from receiving a multi-day special use permit liquor license as of this date.

All necessary documents and local fees pertaining to these license applications have been received from the applicants.
