



Tax Break for Illinois Small Business EXPANDED

Eligible wage now \$10/hr; Encourages hire of "Put Illinois to Work"-ers

Small Businesses

- Eligible if, as of June 30, 2010, you employed 50 or fewer full-time employees (counting all locations)

Eligible Jobs

- Created between 7/1/10 - 6/30/11
- Position pays no less than \$10/hour or equivalent with minimum \$18,200 annually.
- Position sustained for at least one year (not necessarily held by the same individual for the year).
- Withholding tax goes to Illinois.
- Hourly or full-time, but not partners or independent contractors.

Tax Credits

- Certificate after one year

Businesses Hiring Put Illinois to Work-ers

- Any-size business that hires a participant in 2010 "Put Illinois to Work" program

Eligible Jobs

- Position filled by 2010 "Put Illinois to Work" worker-trainee
- Created between 7/1/10 - 6/30/11
- Position pays no less than \$10/hour or equivalent with minimum \$18,200 annually.
- Position sustained for at least one year.
- Withholding tax goes to Illinois.
- Hourly or full-time, but not partners or independent contractors.

Tax Credits

- Certificate at six months and one year
