Unlawful Restraint
Batavia Police Report # 22-1017

On Monday, January 31, 2022, Batavia Police were dispatched to a residence in the 1000 Block of Lorlyn Circle to check on the welfare of a female subject. Officers were subsequently notified that the female and another subject, identified as Jesus Martinez-Tellez, 23, of the 1200 Block of Terrace View Drive in Aurora, IL, had been located by Deputies of the Kane County Forest Preserve Police outside the city limits of Batavia. It was learned that Martinez-Tellez was the subject of an active and served Order of Protection, protecting the female. Additionally, it was learned that Martinez-Tellez had forced the female into a vehicle in the 1000 block of Lorlyn Circle, took her cell phone away from her, and drove away with the female in the vehicle.

Following additional investigation and consultation with the Kane County State's Attorney's Office, Martinez-Tellez was charged with the following:

- Unlawful Restraint, 720 ILCS 5/10-3(a), a Class 4 felony.
- Violation of Order of Protection, 720 ILCS 5/12-3.4(a)(1), a Class A Misdemeanor.
- Domestic Battery (Insulting/Provoking Contact, 720 ILCS 5/12-3.2(a)(2), a Class A Misdemeanor.
- Interference with the reporting of Domestic Battery, 720 ILCS 5/12-3.5(a), a Class A Misdemeanor.

Martinez-Tellez was arrested and is currently awaiting bond call. Anyone who may have witnessed this incident or has additional information is asked to call the Batavia Police Investigations Division at (630) 454-2500.

The charges against Martinez-Tellez are not proof of guilt. Martinez-Tellez is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the State's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
