RE: Class F Liquor License Application for the "Cocktails in the Park" event hosted by Batavia Main Street to be held at Appleton Park, 100 Island Ave, Batavia Illinois on July 31, 2021

The Batavia Police Department conducted an updated investigation and background check (Report #21-6505) to determine whether the corporation (Batavia Main Street Inc.), a not-for-profit corporation located at 5 E. Wilson St and the Executive Director Beth Walker, might be suitable to receive a 1-day temporary Outdoor Class F liquor license in the City of Batavia for their annual special event (Cocktails in the Park) at Appleton Park, 100 N. Island Ave on Saturday, July 31, 2019 from 6-11 p.m..

Numerous Batavia Main Street staff, board members and volunteers will be on hand to oversee liquor service and will act as security at the points of entry and exit.

We have found no problems which would preclude the corporation or director from receiving a temporary liquor license as of this date. All required documents have been submitted with this application by the event organizer.

The organizers have asked that any fees related to this application be waived in conjunction with the fundraiser.
