RE: Hall Quarry Beach Proclamation

On July 9, 2021, a young adult was pulled from the Hall Quarry Beach by the Park District Lifeguards in an apparent near drowning and the fire department was notified. It is uncertain what interventions were implemented by the park district staff prior to the arrival of the fire department, but it was apparent that the victim had an incident in the water. The paramedics administered Advanced Life Support treatment and transported the victim to the hospital. The quick action of the park district lifeguards and staff and the treatment from the fire department paramedics were instrumental in giving this person every chance to survive. The attached Proclamation recognizes their efforts to save this person's life. The Park District details are as follows:

On the afternoon of Friday, July 9, 2021, a successful rescue effort was conducted on an adult patron at Hall Quarry Beach. The safety and well-being of patrons and staff is the Park District's number one concern. We are thankful that staff's dedication and training caused them to spring into swift, life-saving action during this incident. Our sincere thanks go to everyone involved. We send the young man involved in this incident and his family our best wishes and remain grateful for the outpouring of support we have received from the community.
