RE: Class G Special Use Permit - Liquor License Applications for Bar Evolution for the 2021 "Flags and Flannel Event" hosted by the Fox Valley Patriotic Organization to be held in the 0-99 Block of South Water Street on Friday, August 13, 2021.

This memorandum is regarding the management of liquor service for the Fox Valley Patriotic Organization's Special Event "Flags and Flannel" scheduled to take place on Friday, August 13 from 6-11 pm. The event organizer has indicated that liquor services for the event will be provided Bar Evolution. Fox Valley Patriotic Organization will provide event staff at all points of entry/exit to ensure alcoholic beverages are contained within the event area during service hours. Additionally, members of the Police Department staff will monitor the event.

Authorized representative for the licensed liquor holder is as indicated below:

- Bar Evolution: John Hamel (on-street service)

The liquor license vendor holds a valid retail liquor license in the City of Batavia. The Police Department has reviewed the most recent liquor license background investigation completed on the business and we have found no problems which would preclude the business or the owner from receiving a special use permit liquor license as of this date.

All necessary documents and local fees pertaining to the license application have been received from the applicant.
