The Batavia Police Department Investigations Unit conducted an investigation and background check (Report #21-9291) to determine whether the business, Fernando’s Street Kitchen Inc., located at 12 S. Water Street, and the president, (Fernando Martinez), might be suitable to receive a Class D-1 (Restaurant – All Liquor) liquor license in the City of Batavia. It should be noted, Fernando Martinez currently holds a valid Class I (Caterer) Liquor License for his catering business of the same name which operates out of 6 N. River Street, Batavia IL 60510. All required documents have been submitted by the business and we have found no problems which would preclude the business or executive operator from receiving a Class D-1 (Restaurant – All Liquor) Liquor License as of this date.
