RE: Approval: Class F Liquor License for the "Batavia Community Dinner Table" hosted by Batavia Main Street to be held in 0-99 N. River St, Batavia Illinois on August 7, 2022

The Batavia Police Department conducted an updated investigation and background check (Report #22-6863) to determine whether the corporation (Batavia Main Street Inc.), a not-for-profit corporation located at 5 E. Wilson St, the executive director (Beth Walker), and other member (Kathleen Kuchta) might be suitable to receive a 1-day temporary Outdoor Class F liquor license in the City of Batavia for their annual special event (Batavia Community Dinner Table) at 1 N. River St on Sunday, August 7, 2022, from approximately 4:00 to 7:00 pm.

All required documentation has been submitted by the director. We have found no problems which would preclude the corporation, executive director or other members from receiving a temporary liquor license as of this date. Submitters request their not-for-profit status be taken into consideration and the \$50.00 application fee be waived.
